

1) To see people throughout Beacon Hill and beyond be transformed by the lifechanging hope, love and care of Jesus Christ, in community.


2) To see people throughout Beacon Hill and beyond, in community, transformed by power of gospel to bring the hope, love and care of Jesus Christ to others.

# Relying on God and his love letter, the Bible.


- **Proverbs 3:5-6:** Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.
- Hebrews 4:12: For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing the division of soul and spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the through and intensions of the heart.
- 2 Timothy 3:16-17: All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that map of God may be complete



# Welcoming Generously

Generously providing hospitality to newcomers, neighbours, and one another.

- Hebrews 13:2: God expects us show hospitality to strangers because you do not know when an angel of the Lord would visit you.
- **Romans 15:7**: Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God.

- **1 Peter 4:10**: Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others.
- 1 Corinthians 12:7: A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other.
- Ecclesiastes 4:9: Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their toil.



### Caring Compassionately

#### Meeting the needs in our community and church with mercy, kindness, and respect.

- Matthew 25: 4: I tell you the truth, when you refused to help the least of these my brothers and sisters, you were refusing to help me.
- •Matthew 25:35-36: For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.
- Luke 6:36: Therefore, be merciful, just as your Father also is merciful.



# Stewarding Responsibly

Stewarding people, resources, time, and all of creation to bless current and future generations.

- Luke 12:48: Everyone to whom much was given, of him much will be required, and from him to whom they entrusted much, they will demand the more.
